Loading software files that have been zipped onto a USB drive.

NOTE: This software should <u>ONLY</u> be loaded to a USB drive through a PC or laptop.

 Download the zip file from the website. Note where the file is downloaded to on the computer.



- 2. Open the folder with the zipped software file or download it from the website (see Figure 1).
- 3. Click on the attached file and drag it onto the desktop of the computer (see Figure 2).
- 4. Double click and open the zipped folder (see Figure 3).

- 5. Insert a blank USB drive into the computer. Ensure it is formatted for FAT 32. If using an old drive, delete the files **FIRST**.
- 6. Open the USB drive directory by clicking on start button in the lower left corner of the screen (see Figure 4).



- 7. Click on Computer (see Figure 5).
- Locate the blank USB drive in the directory (see Figure 6).



- 9. Double click on the USB drive to view the blank directory (see Figure 7).
- 10. Click on the file in the zip folder to highlight the file (see Figure 8).
- 11. With the file highlighted, click and drag the file into the blank USB directory. The file will appear in the USB directory (see Figure 9).
- 12. Remove the USB drive and follow the software update instructions to load the software.

- 14. Ensure the USB drive is marked with the software version.
